
This matter comes before the undersigned as to the exemption from electronic public access fees for certain persons; and


IT APPEARING to the court that the Judicial Conference, at its March 14, 1995, session approved the addition of an advisory note to the miscellaneous fee schedules promulgated under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1913, 1914, 1926, and 1930, for the purpose of clarifying the judiciary's policy with respect to granting provisions from electronic public access fees prescribed under those schedules; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING to the Court that an exemption from the electronic public access fees for Best Appraisals Inc. would improve bankruptcy case administration within the district and assist the Court in providing petitions and schedules to Best Appraisals for review; now therefore,

IT IS ORDERED THAT, effective immediately, Best Appraisals Inc. be exempt from payment of the electronic public access fees prescribed by 28 U.S.C. § 1930 (b) in cases in which they are appointed appraisers.
