**GENERAL ORDER 09-01**

**AMENDMENTS TO LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES  
Effective December 1, 2009**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, in order to conform with Time Computation Amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Kentucky be AMENDED in the following manner:

**RULE 3001-1 CLAIMS AND EQUITY SECURITY INTERESTS - GENERAL**

**(b) Secured and Priority Claims**

All secured claims and priority claims of creditors should:

- (1) be filed in the Clerk's office within ~~three (3)~~ *seven (7)* business days preceding the meeting of creditors; and

**RULE 3012-1 VALUATION OF COLLATERAL**

- (c) The motion should be filed with the proposed plan or no later than ~~ten (10)~~ *twenty one (21)*\* days prior to the scheduled confirmation hearing in order for the motion to be heard in conjunction with the confirmation hearing.

*\* Time period enlarged to allow 20 days notice in addition to compliance with time computation amendments.*

**RULE 4001-1 AUTOMATIC STAY - RELIEF FROM**

**(d) Effect of No Response to Motion in Chapter 7 Case**

In a Chapter 7 case, if no response to the stay motion is filed within ~~fifteen (15)~~ *fourteen (14)* days, the relief requested will be granted.

**(e) Hearing for Good Cause in Chapter 7 Case**

A hearing will be scheduled within thirty (30) days of the date of filing the motion if:

- (1) the response is filed within ~~fifteen (15)~~ *fourteen (14)* days of the date of service of the stay motion; and

**(f) Chapter 13 Motions**

- (4) The debtor will have ~~fifteen (15)~~ *fourteen (14)* days to respond to the motion. . . .

**RULE 4070-1 INSURANCE**

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
**(b) Insurance Lapse on Motor Vehicles**

- (3) If the debtor fails to provide proof of reinsurance for a minimum period of ninety (90) days to the creditor within ~~five (5)~~ *seven (7)* days following mailing of the notice provided in subsection 4070-1(b)(1) of this rule, the stay shall be deemed terminated upon the filing of a certification of non-insurance.


**RULE 5071-1 CONTINUANCE**

- (a) All motions to continue hearings must:
- (1) be in writing; and
  - (2) filed at least ~~ten (10)~~ *seven (7)* days before the scheduled hearing date.
