

# What's New With Version 2.4 & 2.5

## External Users

### WHAT'S NEW

<b>Automatic Assignment/Scheduling</b>	UST will have access to View 341 Calendar Entry. (No PACER Charge)
<b>Batch/Multicase Docketing</b>	Previously, an event that included the addition of a party would add the party only to the first case selected. Now, <b>all</b> cases in the group are updated correctly.
<b>Claims Register</b>	Previously, the creditor search was case sensitive. Now, the application will ignore case when finding creditors matching the name entered by the user.

<p><b>Credit Card Module</b></p>	<p>The U.S. Treasury is changing the way it processes credit card payments. The user will notice a few changes to the credit card payment process.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Address Information Screen</b> - will be displayed on the filer's screen. The filer's address information will be pre-filled with the address information currently on file in CM/ECF. Changes made to the credit card payment screen will not affect the CM/ECF data.</li> <li>• <b>Credit Card Authorization</b> - is required. The system will display a checkbox that must be selected in order to authorize the payment.</li> <li>• <b>E-mail Confirmation</b> - is another convenient way to receive confirmation of payment. On the authorization screen, the filer has the option of entering an e-mail address to receive confirmation of the payment from pay.gov. E-mail addresses added on the screen will not affect the e-mail address on file in CM/ECF.</li> <li>• <b>Receipt Printing</b> - is now available. Once the payment is made and a receipt is generated, the filer now has an option to print the receipt.</li> <li>• The updated Credit Card Manual may be found on the Courts website at <a href="http://www.kywb.uscourts.gov">www.kywb.uscourts.gov</a></li> </ul>
<p><b>Creditor and Party Selection for Forms</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No longer case sensitive.</li> <li>• Address information has been added to the data shown for creditors and participants.</li> <li>• Participants are now sorted by name.</li> </ul>

<b>File Claims</b>	The creditor search is no longer case sensitive. The name is now the first item on each line of the creditor selection list.
<b>Legal Research Menu Items</b>	Previously, items on the Legal Research menu were links to other Web sites. When a user selected one of the items, he would leave the CM/ECF session and could not go back to it. Now, these items point to CM/ECF programs rather than to hyperlinks; when one is selected, a new browser window opens and the CM/ECF session remains. Also, an option for Lexis/Nexis has been added to the menu
<b>Miscellaneous</b>	<p>1. A Notice of Electronic Filing is sent to a user's primary email address and to every secondary email address. A "free look" is given when the recipient clicks the document link in the primary NEF. Previously, one additional free look was given the first time someone clicked the document link in any of the secondary NEF; thereafter, the user was billed. Now a free look is available for the primary NEF and for <u>each</u> secondary NEF.</p> <p>2.To improve the performance of CM/ECF, the time period for a "free look" has been decreased to 15 days.</p>
<b>PACER Transaction Receipt</b>	Billing transactions did not include enough data to make them unique; as a result the software used by the PACER Service Center software to process the transactions was incorrectly deleting some as duplicates. Also, more information has been added to the transaction receipt to provide users with better documentation of the data retrievals they have requested.
