



The Court finding that on August 2, 2021, the United States District Court for the Western District of Kentucky entered [General Order No. 21-16, Twelfth Supplemental Order Concerning Court Operations Related to COVID-19](#), and that General Order 21-16, in response to revised guidelines issued by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, requires all persons over two years of age to wear a face covering or mask when entering courthouses and courtrooms located in areas of substantial or high transmission of COVID-19,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that General Order 21-16 entered by the United States District Court, as well as all subsequent General Orders the U.S. District Court may enter regarding courthouse access in the Western District of Kentucky, apply to all parties wishing to enter the District’s courthouses and access public areas used by this Court, including the lobby area of the Bankruptcy Clerk’s Office in Louisville.
